A1C Christoffer P. Johnson, July 5, 1990-February 17, 2011.

Christoffer was serving as a member of the Air Force Security Forces in support of Operation New Dawn. He died February 17, 2011 while on final security patrol at Al Udeid Air Base in Qatar.
