He successfully managed NCL's Jamaica Hill Resort located in Portland, Jamaica. In 1981 Alvin migrated to Miami, Florida with his family where he continued his employment with NCL. Higher education was foremost in Alvin's goal in life. He obtained a bachelor's degree at Barry University and a master's degree in International Business at St.Thomas University in Miami. Alvin became the Vice President of Purchasing and Logistics and also was named the President of the Florida Marine Hotel Association(2011-2013) all in the 30 year tenure at NCL.
