### Obituary of Anita Wynns

Wynns, Anita Elise Schroeder, 87, Bushnell, FL passed away on Saturday, August 21, 2010 at Good Shepards West ALF in DeLand, FL. Anita was born in Daytona Beach, FL on March 21, 1923 to George and Kate Colton Schroeder. In Daytona Beach, she attended Lennox Elementary and Seabreeze High School. While attending Stetson University School of Music in DeLand, FL, she met Clifford Wynns of Bushnell, FL. Anita and Clifford "Cliff" were married in 1943 in Daytona Beach and eventually moved to Bushnell where they made their home. They were married for 62 years and had four children. Besides being a devoted wife and mother, Anita donated her time and talents to the community with her service to the Bushnell Woman's Club, the Beta Sigma Phi Sorority, the First United Methodist Church as choir director, and in helping raise funds for various charity organizations.
