Obituary of Ann Harrison

Ann Eliopolo Harrison of Leesburg, FL died Saturday, November 27, 2010 at Bayview Center in Eustis, FL after a brief illness. Mrs. Harrison was born October 20, 1913 in Savannah, GA to Mamie Mark and John J. Eliopolo. She graduated from Savannah High School and then moved to Atlanta, GA where she worked as an air traffic controller while attending law school at night. She met and married her husband, Willis A. Harrison, while he was serving in the Army Air Corp during World War II. As an Air Force wife she accompanied her husband to a variety of posts. After her husband's retirement, the Harrison's settled in Wildwood, FL. During her career Mrs. Harrison held a number of positions including city manager of Wildwood, manager of Leesburg Transfer and Storage and office manager for Mr. Fred Duncan. Following her husband's death she moved to Leesburg. She was a member of St. James Episcopal Church.

Mrs. Harrison was predeceased in death by her parents, husband and six siblings. She is survived by four nephews, one niece, one great nephew and two great nieces. She will always be remembered for her independent spirit and her willingness to help others.
