Obituary of Anne Marie Tumlin

Anne Marie Tumlin passed away on Tuesday, September 24, 2013. She was born April 1, 1932, in Leesburg, FL, to the late Leroy and Frances Oetjen. She graduated from Leesburg High School and then studied nursing at Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia, where she met her husband, Dr. Paul Tumlin. They married in 1951, and were married 49 years until his death in 2000. She worked by his side in his medical practice in Leesburg for over 35 years until their retirement. Anne Marie was a loving wife to Paul and instrumental in helping him provide care for a whole generation of families in Leesburg. She loved Leesburg and remained close to many of her childhood friends. She was a member of the Leesburg Historical Society and Junior Women's Club.
