Obituary of Arnold Garren

Dr. Arnold E. Garren, 88, passed away peacefully in his home on December 14, 2014, with his loving wife of 57 years by his side. Arnold was born in Andrews, NC and spent his childhood years growing up on a mountain farm. He served in the US Navy during WWII aboard the USS San Francisco as a Machinist's Mate, Third Class. He was awarded the American Theater Medal, Asiatic Pacific Medal 4 Stars, Philippine Liberation Ribbon 1 star and the Victory Medal. He had an unparalleled love for our country and continued to be a strong supporter of Navy servicemen until his passing. He was an active lifetime (50 years) member of the American Legion.

After leaving military service, he worked his way through college earning his Doctorate of Chiropractic from The National College of Chiropractic in Chicago, IL. After graduation he opened a successful Chiropractic practice in Mebane, NC until he retired. He served his community in many ways throughout his lifetime, one of which was as a Boy Scout Leader for 16 years. To those who knew him best, he will always be remembered as an all American man.
