Arnold Edwin Siedelmann, 85, Lady Lake, FL. passed from this life Wednesday, April 9, 2014. Born in Exira, IA, he resided in retirement in Lady Lake, FL with his wife Florence. Arnold served in the United States Navy and then worked with his older brother in construction before joining the Ames Police Department as a patrolman. He quickly advanced to Chief of Police in Ames.
