Obituary of Arthur Doggett

Arthur "Terry" Doggett died peacefully at the Florida Hospital in Orlando on Tuesday, October 28, 2014 at the age of 68.

Terry is survived by his loving wife of 49 years, Nancy Bailey Doggett of The Villages, FL, his sons Tim of Wenham, MA, Chris of Mansfield, CT and Scott of Oakland, FL, 6 grandchildren who knew him as "Grampy" and his sister Lee Ford of Portsmouth, NH.
