Obituary of Arthur Knight

Arthur Westberry Knight died on September 20, 2011, at the age of 83 in Leesburg, FL. He will be remembered as a loving husband, father, stepfather, and grandfather. He is survived by Kathryn, his wife of 32 years. Mr. Knight was a proud third generation Floridian, born and raised in Jacksonville, FL. He received his high school education from Georgia Military Academy. Upon completion, he served in the U.S. Navy for four years during the Korean Conflict. He received his college degree in Business Administration from Florida State University where he was a member of the SAE Fraternity and remained an avid FSU sports fan throughout his life. Mr. Knight moved to Leesburg in 1956 where he worked as an accountant for Manly Construction Co. and later as a realtor, his profession at the time of his retirement.
