This work project consisted of development and improvement of the Tunxis State Forest with creation of recreational areas, road and trails, disease and pest control. He also served in the U. S. Army during World War II stationed in England and France.

He was the co-founder of Circle A Automotive and Truck Repair in Hamden, CT. An avid golfer, he was a former longstanding member of Wallingford Country Club where he had 3 hole in ones and one windshield. He also had a hole in one in Freeport, Bahamas and one in Hamden, CT. While in The Villages he "shot his age" many times.

Mr. Longley was a Mason with Adelphi Momauguin Lodge #63 in New Haven, CT.

Mr. Longley was one of the founding members of the (CT) Elm City Banjo Society. For the past two years he played banjo with The Jammers and the Acoustic Guitar Club in The Villages, FL and sat on the back of a golf cart strumming his banjo in many of The Villages parades.
