Obituary of Arthur Newett

Arthur W. Newett, Jr., 89, of Leesburg, FL died Monday, August 23, 2010. Born in Groveland, FL, he grew up in Leesburg and graduated from Leesburg High School. He was a B-26 bomber navigator during WW II and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and Air Medal with clusters. After returning from his missions in Europe, he became a bomber pilot. He was a graduate engineer from Purdue University and worked with several firms in Jacksonville and Orlando as a structural engineer. He retired with his wife to Leesburg in 1989. He was a member and past president of the Leesburg Lunchtime Kiwanis Club, the Lake County Conservation Council and the Harris Chain Sailing Club.

He is survived by his wife, Vicky, his son Michael L. Newett of Ft. Lauderdale, FL and his sister Marty Dixon of Greensboro, N.C.
