### Obituary of Aubrey Munn

Aubrey Carl Munn, 88, of Fruitland Park, FL was born December 4, 1925 in Kissimmee, FL and passed away peacefully on October 9, 2014. A veteran of the US Navy, he proudly served his country during WWII and in 1964 founded Munn's Air Conditioning. He attended the Leesburg Missionary Baptist Church and was formerly a longtime member of Whitney Baptist Church. Additionally he served as a Volunteer Fireman for Leesburg and as a member of the Florida Highway Patrol Auxiliary and the Elks Lodge.
