Obituary of Beatrice Williams Wynn

Beatrice Elayne Loucks Williams Wynn, 90, of Leesburg, FL was born April 8, 1923 in West Union, SC to Kenneth and Julia Loucks and passed away peacefully on January 21, 2014. Elayne lived in Leesburg since about the third grade, graduated from Leesburg High School and attended Huntingdon College in Montgomery, AL.
