Obituary of Beverly Richards

Beverly Richards of Leesburg, Florida, daughter of the late George Theodore (Ted) and Mary (Minns) Hauck of DuBois, PA passed away on Thursday, October, 13, 2016. She was born on January 26, 1933 and is survived by her daughters, Debi (Jack) MacIntyre and Mary Lynne (Gary) Gentzle; three grandchildren, Michael (Leslie) Gentzle, Heather (John) Hedrick, and Erin Gentzle; and five great-grandchildren, Mason, Landen, and Savannah Hedrick and Jack and Weston Gentzle. She is also survived by her brother George (Jan) Hauck, sister LuAn (Joe) Pedulla and many nieces and nephews. Beverly graduated from DuBois High School in 1950. She earned her R.N. from Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA in 1953 and received her Doctorate of Education at Pennsylvania State University in 1980. She helped to start the first LPN program at Jeff Tech in Reynoldsville, PA; was a tenured professor at the University of Iowa, Pennsylvania State University and retired from North Carolina State in 1997. As a retiree in Florida, Beverly stayed active with volunteer work at St. James Episcopal Church in Leesburg, Angel Flight, Church Women United, and Operation Homebound. She loved to play cards and games, read, do puzzles and was known for her famous chocolate covered cherries, peanut butter eggs, and cinnamon rolls. Beverly loved returning to DuBois every summer to spend time with her family, friends, high school classmates and neighbors in the same neighborhood where she raised

her children.
