February 11, 1957 - October 19, 2019

Dr. Bindoo Narain (62) of Leesburg, FL passed away on October 19, 2019. She was born February 11, 1957 in Pune, India.

Bindoo is survived by her husband of 30 years, Dr. Shakti Narain; Her children, Dr. Punya Narain and Dr. Ravi Shah of Los Angeles, CA and Puja Narain of Chicago, IL; Her brother and sister-in-law, Drs. Rakesh and Veenu Chopra of India; Her cousins, nieces, nephews, and dear family; her beloved friend, Guadalupe Robles; and her dog, Chandini. She was preceded in death by her parents Dr. and Mrs. T.R. Chopra, and her uncle, Dr. Hari Malik.

Dr. Narain dedicated her life as a pediatrician for 40 years. She loved children passionately, caring not only for their medical needs in Leesburg for 30 years, but also as an advocate and avid humanitarian for women and children in need. She had a gift for fundraising to help assist families less fortunate than herself. She never sought recognition for her accomplishments and services but aided others out of her loving heart.
