Blair "Buzz" Gingrich, Age 86, died August 26, 2018.

Buzz was born in Harrisburg, PA and moved to The Villages (Orange Blossom Gardens) in 1987. He was employed by USF&G Life Insurance Co as a Life Insurance/Sales and Marketing Consultant with 32 years of service.
