“ This afternoon, I received a call that I really did not expect. Amber called to tell me that my best friend in the world had died unexpectedly of a heart attack. He felt some pain and pressure while at church, decided to go to the emergency room, and never made it there. He died on the way.

I only met Brad in 2014, but we had lived in the same town in Pennsylvania and immediately found a rapport that we did not have with other people. When I was in Florida, we would meet for coffee, with or without our wives, and we would talk for hours. Carol, my wife, says I never talk to people, but with Brad, we always had something to say.

Our dinners together with Carol and Marcia were always special. WE HAD FUN! We went together for soft serve. We all felt like we were kids again when we were with each other and that was very special. I don't think I have ever felt a loss like this, our relationship was irreplaceable.

How many times have I experienced the same thing? Felt the pain and pressure, went to the emergency room and found that I had had a heart attack, congestive heart failure or a stroke. Somehow, even with all that going on, we never really think this is the end. Brad did, he said to Marcia "I am gone" and he went to meet God. I am sure he will be welcomed into the holy kingdom of heaven.

I remember my Dad telling me that his friends were dying and he could not replace them. I was not very compassionate, I told him to make new friends, find new people to play gin with. I never understood the loss he was feeling. I understand it now!

Brad, we all are going to miss you. You did wonderful things for your church and for your children, and especially for you friends. There is simply no way to replace you in our hearts or in our minds.
