Obituary of Brenda Clement

Brenda Elaine Clement (Hussey) 71, The Villages, FL passed away surrounded by family and friends on Wednesday, February 27, 2013 at Cornerstone Hospice, The Villages, FL after a courageous battle with cancer. She was born in Berwick, ME on February, 14, 1942 to Oscar and Vivian Hussey (Morrill) and was raised on the family farm. Brenda was educated in Berwick schools and graduated from Berwick High School in 1960. She worked her way through college and earned a teaching degree from the University of New Hampshire.
