### Obituary of Carl Sosnowski Sr.

The Villages- Carl R. Sosnowski, Sr., 83, died on Thursday, February 5, 2015 at his home in the Villages. Mr. Sosnowski was born in Wilkes-Barre Pa. on October 16th, 1931. Carl graduated from Coughlin High School in 1949, and then enlisted in United States Air Force, where he achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant. After the U.S. Air Force, Carl attended Kings College in Wilkes-Barre Pa., where he received his BA in Business. He belonged to the Regis Club and was also President of the Alumni Association.
