### Obituary of Carlton E. Kilpatrick

KILPATRICK, CARLTON E. JR. "GENE", age 69, of Leesburg, FL, died on January 2, 2014, due to complications from Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis. He was born in Brooksville, FL, on January 31, 1944, the son of Carlton Sr. and Irene (nee Blackburn). He attended Hernando High School. He earned a BA in Spanish at the University of South Florida (1966) and taught Spanish at Leesburg Junior High School. After earning an MLS in Library Science at the Florida State University (1969), he accepted a position at Tavares High School as the Media Specialist, where he continued until his retirement in 2008. While at Tavares High, he spent many years as the Senior Class sponsor and Hi-Q/Brain Bowl coach. He was known for his dry wit, musical gifts, and generosity.

He is survived by his daughter Mary Susan and granddaughter Annakiya (North Andover, MA), his son Carlton III (Altamonte Springs), and sisters Gloria and Eugenia (Canada).
