Obituary of Carolyn Mills

Carolyn A. Mills, 86, formerly of Leesburg, Florida, passed away on Sunday, June 21, 2015. She and her husband Rhod (deceased), had been residents at the Life Care Center since moving to Punta Gorda in 2011. Carolyn retired in 1983 from a long teaching career with New Lexington City Schools in Ohio. Although she taught briefly in the upper grades, her real love was teaching kindergarten students to read their first words, and almost any baby boomer who grew up in New Lexington went through her classroom. After retiring, she and Rhod moved to Pennbrooke Fairways in Leesburg. Both she and Rhod remained active in church and local civic activities until their health forced them to move to full-time care.
