Cecil's body will be cremated at Beyers Funeral and will be given a full military celebration at the Florida National Cemetery in Bushnell, Florida. I will have a street in Florida named after my love, Captain of the Military Intelligence, recipient of Harvard scholarship, and later a Pastor to minister millions, was my Cecil C. Lane.
