Obituary of Rev. Charles Coit, II

The Rev. Charles Henry Coit II, 88, passed away suddenly on March 19, 2015, at Lexington Park Assisted Living. Charles was born March 28, 1926 in Cleveland, OH to the late William C. Coit and Anna Dix North Coit. Charles was a World War II Veteran who served in the United States Navy.

He graduated in 1950, from Ohio University with a BS in Architectural Engineering and worked for 10 years at Marathon Oil Co. He returned to school at 36 and received a Masters of Divinity from Colgate Rochester Divinity School Bexely Hall. He was ordained as an Episcopal Priest in 1965 and devoted himself to the ministry for 41 years. His churches include St. Andrew's, Elyria, OH., Trinity Church, Fostoria, OH., St. Luke's, Live Oak, FL., St. Catherine's, Jacksonville, FL., and St. James, Macclenny, FL.

Charles is survived by his wife of 63 years, Alma Mae Pollard Coit, whom he married in 1951. Their children include Victoria North Coit, Charles Henry Coit III, John Clark Coit and daughter-in-law Robin Brooks Coit. He had four grandchildren, Amanda Coit McGregor Cejka, Oliver Brooks Coit, Hannah Clark Coit and Christopher Dylan Coit Aversa as well as 3 great grandchildren, Jay, Jonathan and Molly Cejka. He was preceded in death by his brother, William Clark Coit II, son Charles Henry Coit III and grandson

Shawn Michael McGregor.

His life was spent in service to others. He volunteered for TORCH (Teen Outreach for Christian Help), was very active in Cursillo, the American Red Cross and Operation Shoebox.

Charles will be laid to rest in the Bishop's Garden at St. John's Cathedral in Jacksonville, FL.
