Obituary of Charles Foley

Charles David(Dave)Foley went home to be with his Lord on Thursday, February 16, 2012. He was born August 27, 1945, in Barberton, Ohio. He lived in the Akron area and worked with his father and brother at Foley & Sons Construction until he moved to Sarasota, Florida in 1978, where he continued as a General Contractor and developer.

He was a member of the 1963 Barberton High School State Championship football team and served in the US Army, Corps of Engineers at West Point, during which time he reported directly to General William Westmoreland. He was a dedicated dad who officiated at his son and daughter's sporting events; a loving, indulgent grandfather, his granddaughter being the joy of his life; and a dedicated son who moved to Fruitland Park, Florida in 2005 to care for his father and mother where he met his wife, Glenda. Dave was an avid sportsman who loved fishing and golfing. He was an active member of Eagles Nest Baptist Church, served as Sunday School Director and was a member of the adult choir.
