Obituary of Charles Lynn

Charles Gordon Lynn (better known as Don) age 76, The Villages, FL died on Wednesday, September 9, 2009, after a brief illness. He was survived by his beloved partner, Barbara Miles of The Villages, his daughter Elizabeth Anne Lynn of Jackson, NJ, his son, Lawrence Andrew Lynn of Virginia Beach, VA and was the proud grandfather to Christopher Lynn, age 13, and the apple of his eye.

Don had been a resident of The Villages for over 16 years, and was an active participant in many different organizations. He was one of the founding fathers of Saint George Episcopal Church, the prime mover in the development of The Villages AARP Tax-Aide program, a 5 year veteran writer on taxes for The Villages Daily Sun and instrumental in the formation of the Villages Fair Tax movement. He also was an accomplished bridge player and a gifted tennis player in his early years.

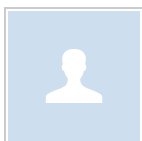
