Obituary of Charles Miller

CHARLES F. MILLER, 83, of The Villages, FL died Easter Sunday morning, March 27, 2016 at Leesburg Regional Medical Center, Leesburg, FL.

He was born July 20, 1932 to Charles Fritz Miller and Georgine White in Vicksburg, MS at his home, on land that is now part of the Vicksburg National Cemetery. Charlie grew up in New Orleans, LA, attended LSU in Baton Rouge, LA and graduated from McNeese State University in Lake Charles, LA with a BS degree in Geology. During his business career he obtained the CLU designation.

Charlie served in the military on the aircraft carrier Midway during the Korean Conflict.

On July 9, 1955 he married J. Maxine Loftin at Mater Dolorosa Catholic church in New Orleans, LA. They have 5 children, 14 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

In 1994 Charlie retired from his executive position with Metropolitan Life Insurance Company after a 17 year tenure. He and Maxine moved to The Villages in 1997.

He is survived by his wife J. Maxine Miller (aka Jmax) of 60 years, their children: Lori, Leslie, Marc, Julie and Joy and a cousin, Phylliss Stevenson who lives in a community just north of The Villages.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at St. Timothy Catholic Church in The Villages, FL on Wednesday, April 6, 2016 at 8:30 a.m.
