He became a member of the VFW Post 8645, New Paltz, NY in 1949, Past Commander in 1952, life member in 1977, and treasurer for more than 25 years. He also was a former Deacon of the Dutch Reform Church of New Paltz, NY and former member of the New Paltz Volunteer Fire Department.
