### Obituary of Charles Winn

Charles William (Bill) Winn, 71, passed away on Thursday, July 10, 2014, at his home. He was the devoted husband of Lorna, the loving father of Jennifer and Ryan, and a devoted Grandpa who was also a great friend. A teacher, coach, and school administrator for 38 years, he made a huge impact in the lives of countless students. After retiring from the public school system, he established and helped implement three Christian schools. He mentored, inspired, led, befriended, and nurtured so many. He saw the best in people and encouraged them to reach their potential. He was a man of strength, integrity and unshakeable faith.

He is survived by Lorna, his wife of 48 years; two children, Jennifer (Steve) McMichael of Tanger, Morocco and Ryan (Eli) Winn of Bloomington, IL; two grand daughters, Leah McMichael and Emerson Winn; and a brother Ron Winn of Tampa, FL.
