Obituary of Chester Haynes

CHESTER HAROLD HAYNES, 88, of Leesburg, died , Friday, November 26, 2010. Born in Clear Lake, Washington he moved to Leesburg in 1968 from Fairfax, VA. He was a retired Lt. Col. in the U.S. Army serving 28 years. He was a veteran of WWII. He was awarded the Combat Infantry Badge, Purple Heart, Presidential Unit Citation and Bronze Star for Valor with 2 clusters.
