



Christopher Lee Cheshire

Christopher "Lee" Cheshire was born in Enterprise, Alabama on December 6, 1969, and died at his home in Eustis, Florida, on December 6, 2017. At a young age Lee moved to Lake County where he was raised by his grandparents, Mel and Reba. Lee graduated from Umatilla High School in 1988. After a brief stint in the Army, Lee completed police academy training and was hired as a patrol officer with the Umatilla Police Department. In 1994, Lee began a career at the Lake County Sheriff's Office, a job he loved until the progression of ALS necessitated his retirement at the rank of Lieutenant in 2014. During his tenure at the Sheriff's Office Lee was an instructor, and worked in nearly every department, including the canine unit, marine patrol and drug unit. He also served as Commander of the Sheriff's S.W.A.T. team. Lee was awarded the Sheriff's Medal of Honor for his bravery in the line of duty. Lee loved to hunt and fish, but mostly he loved his family and Alabama football.

Lee is survived by his wife of nearly 18 years, Kimberly (Rader) Cheshire and their two sons, Chance and Riley Cheshire. The family requests in lieu of flowers that donations be made to the Lee Cheshire Memorial Fund which has been established at United Southern Bank.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 9, 2017 at the Lifepointe Church in Eustis, FL.
