Connie Massey, 76, of The Villages, passed away Thursday, June 7, 2018. She was born and raised in Artesia, California and graduated from Artesia High School. She was married to Farrell Massey, Benton, Arkansas, who was in the U.S. Navy.

After her husband's discharge from active duty, they relocated to Dallas, Texas.
