April 25, 1956 - August 18, 2023

Cynthia "Cindi" Elizabeth (Neely) McRae (lovingly called CC) died at her home in Leesburg, Florida on Friday, August 18, 2023. She was 67.

A beloved woman of God, Cindi loved lifting up in prayer her Facebook friends and she made it her daily mission to inspire as many people as possible with love and encouragement. Cindi was born in Dearborn, Michigan and moved to Eustis, Florida as a young girl.
