Obituary of David Heydt

David Heydt passed peacefully on February 7 from complications of Alzheimer's disease. He joined his beloved wife Jeanette in the arms of his Lord.

David was born in Lancaster, PA. He was the son of Dr. Henry J. and Margaret Heydt. After graduating from Lancaster Bible College, where he met Jeanette and where his father was founder and President, he was a schoolteacher and tennis coach. He then followed his calling to the ministry, attending seminary in Denver, Colorado and ministering to churches in PA, MD and NJ. He continued his ministry as a hospital chaplain, at the Mayo Clinic in Minnesota and at Baptist Hospital in Miami.

After retiring from the Chaplaincy and moving to The Villages, David worked with Beyers Funeral Home, ministering in a support program to widows and widowers in the LIFE Program.

David is fondly remembered for his sense of humor, beautiful prayers, strong

faith, everlasting love for his family, and the grace with which he approached his disease. David is survived by his three children, Phillip, Sandy and Lori, his 5 grandchildren and 4 great-grandchildren.

A memorial celebration of his life will be held at First Baptist Church of The Villages, 7570 SE Hwy. 42, Summerfield, FL 34491 on Saturday, February 13, at 11:00am, preceded by a harp concert at 10:30am.
