Well the morning's so bright

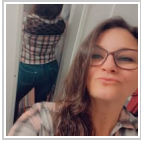
And the lamp is alight

Forever loved. Forever missed.

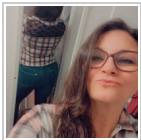

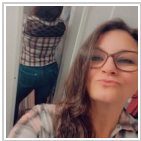
