She then completed a Master's Degree in Nursing at the University of Virginia (UVA) and certification as a nurse practitioner. While in college, she met her future husband, Jason Sheehan. They later married after both graduated from UVA. For most of their married life, they lived in Charlottesville, Virginia. However, Diane lived abroad in Spain while furthering her Spanish studies and in Auckland, New Zealand where she worked for the international humanitarian organization "Save the Children". Diane was also an active owner and manager of her family's orange grove business in central Florida.
