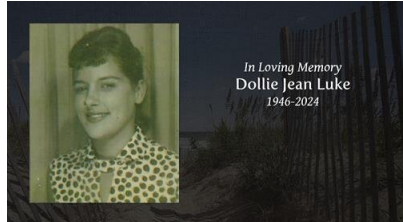
September 7, 1946 - October 7, 2024

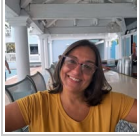
