Obituary of Donald Baron

Donald Jerome Baron of Leesburg, Florida passed after a long illness on December 3, 2014 at Melech Hospice House, Temple Terrace, Florida. He was 84 years old. Born in Erie, PA, January 16, 1930 and was the son of Jerome W. and Helen G. Baron. He served as a 1st Lieutenant in the United States Army during the Korean War. He remained actively involved in Veterans' affairs, frequently singing the national anthem for various memorial services. As a graduate of Gannon University and the University of Illinois, he taught for 33 years in Wilson, NY as a high school English teacher. Upon retiring from teaching, he moved to NC, where he worked as the evening coordinator at Alamance Community College for 5 years. He and his recently deceased wife of 21 years, Mary "Betty" Baron, lived in Pennbrooke Fairways for the last 14 years. He is survived by 6 grandchildren and 3 children: James D., of Tampa FL; Diane L., of Asheville, NC; and Steven J., of Blacklick, OH. In his own words, he believed in: "Country, Love, Music and Truth." Funeral mass will be held at St. Paul's Catholic Church in Leesburg, FL on December 10th at 8:30a.m., followed by visitation at Beyers Funeral Home from 10:00 am - 1:00 pm.
