FAIRALL, Donald M, age 85, passed away peacefully Saturday, November 5, 2016 in Eustis, Florida, surrounded by his loving family. Don was born December 23, 1930 in Fremont, Ohio, and was the son of the late Whitey and Goldie Fairall. He was preceded in his death by his daughter, Karen Fairall-Iwanicki; and his brother, Richard L. Fairall. Mr. Fairall served honorably in the US Air Force during the Korean Conflict from 1951 to 1954 where he earned the rank of Staff Sergeant.
