### Obituary of Donald Maddox

Donald Ray Maddox, 63, of Lady Lake, FL went home to be with the Lord Monday, August 24th, 2015. He was born November 6th, 1951 to Ralph Maddox and Faye Maddox (Robinson) in Ridgely, TN.
