



Donna Hendrickson Covault

April 17, 1928 - December 29, 2022

Donna H. Covault, 94, of Altoona, Florida, died Thursday, December 29, 2022, at Lakeview Terrace. She was born April 17, 1928, in Waukegan, Illinois to Ernest and Lucy Mauck Hendrickson. She grew up in Wilmette and graduated from New Trier High School in 1946. After high school, she attended Purdue University, earning a BS in dietetics in 1950, followed by a year's internship at the Ohio State University Hospital. While at Purdue, she met Donald O. Covault on a blind date arranged by mutual friends. They married on September 1, 1951, in Wilmette. They lived in Madison Wisconsin, Lafayette Indiana, and Atlanta, Georgia, where Don was a professor of civil engineering. She and Don were camping enthusiasts, starting with an old canvas tent and gradually progressing to a 34-foot Airstream trailer, in which they lived full time for seven years. They eventually traveled to all seven continents (not always towing the Airstream), and yes, they went to Antarctica . They traveled well into their 80s and, finally decided to "settle down" at Lakeview Terrace in Altoona, Florida in 2000. Donna worked as a therapeutic dietitian at St. Mary's Hospital in Madison,

Wisconsin and at Dekalb

General Hospital in Decatur, Georgia. She spent several years in between as a full-time homemaker,

raising four gnarly children. She enjoyed singing, gardening, and reading.

Donna was proceeded in death by her parents, sister Nancy M. Hendrickson, infant daughter Delores,

and husband Donald. She is survived by children Nancy Longworth of Indianapolis, Carolyn Echols

Army or Habitat for Humanity.

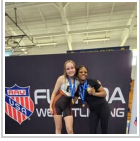
