Obituary of Doris Clark

Doris T. (Thoren) Clark, of Leesburg, formerly of Hanson Massachusetts died Friday after a long illness.

Doris was born in Braintree, Mass. March 11, 1922 , the only daughter of John Arvid Thoren and Sadie C. Nelson. Doris attended the NE Conservatory of Music for voice and organ and remained active and involved in music as a member of the chorus at Plantation where she lived since 1991.

She met her husband, Maynard at the NE Conservatory of Music and they married December 5, 1942. They had 2 sons.

In her early days she was an avid fisherman and somewhat of a pioneer as a woman, receiving the Governors trophy for the largest striped bass for the year in 1959. The men always joked that she must have been using perfume on the hook because she always caught the largest fish. She and her family fished in Massachusetts for many years.

Before moving to Florida, Doris became a real estate broker with her husband in 1963, Maynard where they started Maynard and Doris Clark Realtors in Hanson Mass.

Maynard passed away in 1983 and Doris kept the real estate company going until she retired in 1991. It was then she met Richard Conforti whom she married in 1995. They then relocated from Massachusetts to Plantation in Leesburg, Florida. She had always played golf and her and Richard enjoyed the golf course at Plantation for many years. When she could no longer play golf, she loved to watch and root for the Red Sox.

Doris is survived by her husband, Richard, sons Maynard T. Clark of Winston-Salem, North Carolina and Bruce F. Clark of the Cayman Islands, grandsons Jonathan L. Clark, of Knoxville Tennessee and Christopher N. Clark of the Cayman Islands, Lieutenant Commander Kalohi Clark, stationed in Newport, Rhode Island, and Ramon Clark of Colorado.
