Dorothy "Dot" or "Dort" Magamoll, 83, was welcomed Home in the early morning hours of 7/11/15. Born to Arthur and Ida Langlitz on May 8, 1932, in Marinette, WI, Dort and her big sister, Bunny, experienced all the joys of growing up on the family farm. At the age of 17 Dort was crowned Snow Queen in her Wisconsin high school.

On July 29, 1950, Dort married the milkman, Carl "Chuck" John Magamoll. In 1959 the Magamolls moved with their five children to Florida. Dort stayed busy raising her brood and helping other families in need. She was a Sunday School Teacher, Teacher's Aide and Girl Scout leader in the Umatilla area. She was a fabulous catcher for the Inland Equipment Ladies Softball Team in Leesburg. Many knew Dort as a bartender at Silver Lake Country Club, the Pewter Pub and the Elk's Club. Dorothy's latest passion for the past few years was serving as a volunteer at the Leesburg Food Bank. Dort worshipped at Good News Church of Central Florida and she demonstrated a Christian example for her children,

grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Dorothy was preceded in death by her husband "Chuck" and her son Kelly Steven.
