Douglas E. Rickles passed away on August 14, 2016. Douglas and his parents, Mary and Jim Rickles, moved from Ohio to Bushnell, Florida in the early 1950's where his father served as mayor and his mother was a fifth grade school teacher. Douglas' love for Sumter County began during that time and grew each year of his life. He graduated from Bushnell High School and earned a B.S. in Business Administration from Florida State University. He served in the Army and then started his career with Lockheed/Martin in Orlando. During this time Douglas married his high school sweetheart, Patricia West, and recently they celebrated 56 years together. They were blessed with two children, Stacey and Doug, and three grandchildren, Hannah, Will and Hailey. He was a member of the First United Methodist Church.

After making a career change to the textile division of Monsanto Corporation in 1966, he ascended the corporate ladder in management forecasting working in Pensacola, Greenville SC, New York City and Atlanta. In 1985 Douglas and Patty returned to Bushnell and he began a second career as a probation and parole officer with the State of Florida.
