Doyle "Skeeter" Robbins, 64, passed away on Saturday, May 19, 2018, doing what he loved to do "Fishing". Born in Mobile, Alabama, Skeeter moved to Groveland at a young age. He spent his off work hours dedicated to his community. He held the position of Assistant Fire Chief of Groveland, President of Groveland High School Booster Club, and established the Groveland Youth Football. Players called him "Coach Skeeter" and to this day when one of his players saw him, they would call out "Hey Coach Skeeter". Some of his players went on to play in the NFL.

Skeeter held the position of Superintendent for Florida Crushed Stone "Tully Sand Mine" for 25 years and loved playing with the heavy equipment. At his passing, he was Head Custodian at Minneola Charter Elementary.

Skeeter had been married to his school sweetheart Gay for 44 years. He is survived by his wife Gay, their daughter Lori, and grandsons Dakota and Mason; sisters Donna and Betty; brothers Buddy and L.D.

He absolutely loved fishing with his wife Gay and grandsons Dakota and Mason, and won many local Bass Tournaments. Skeeter was a Bassmaster's member as well as a current member of Orange County Bass.
