EDWARD FOSTER, age 97 of Lakeview Terrace, Altoona, Florida formerly of The Villages, and Gardener, NY passed away on September 5, 2021.

Born on June 1, 1924 in Locust Valley, NY he was the son of Edward and Eva Foster. He married Lois on May 12, 1951. He is survived by Lois, his wife.

He was predeceased by his sisters Eva MacKennon, Madeline Foster and June Wylie. He is survived by nephew, James Wylie, Madeline Kaplan and Nancy Von Ark.

Ed attended Locust Valley Public schools and graduated from Glen Cove High School in June, 1942, and enlisted in the US Navy. He served in the Atlantic and Pacific theaters during WW II and was honorably discharged in March of 1946.

He was employed by Pan American Airways from 1948 to 1955, during which time he attended Pace University.

In 1955, Ed and Lois moved to Gardiner NY and shortly after he joined the IBM Corp, where he was employed for 30 years, retiring in 1986. Ed and Lois resided in Gardener for 50 years during which time Ed was a volunteer in the Gardener Fire department, was Secretary, Treasurer and President of the

Marshall Rod and Gun club, Treasurer of the Republican Club, and served an unfinished term of Justice of the Peace in the Town of Gardener.

He was a member of the Gardener Reformer Church and served as Vice President of the consistory. At the time of his death, he was a member of the First United Methodist church of Mount Dora.

In 2004, Ed and Lois moved to Florida and resided in The Villages, where Ed joined the E-Flyers model airplane club.

In 2011, Ed and Lois moved to Lake View Terrace in Altoona, Florida.

In 2013, Ed and Lois participated in the Honor Flight Program honoring WW II Vets with a trip to Washington, D.C.

Burial will be at the Florida National Cemetery and services are private.
