



Edward L "Punk" Sloan

Edward L "Punk" Sloan, 87, of Slone Ridge, Florida passed away on January 1, 2025. He was born in Leesburg, Florida on February 27, 1937 to Nelia & Dave Sloan. His great-grandfather, Daniel Sloan was in the Civil War. Edward was an avid cattle rancher, vegetable farmer and infamous deer and turkey hunter all his life.

He attended Groveland High School and was later drafted into the United States Army, 4th Cavalry in 1959 where he was a Sergeant and tank driver, gunner, and tank commander until he was discharged on November 30, 1965. While in the Army, he earned three medals for good conduct, marksman "pistol" expert, and sharpshooter rifle, 90mm tank gun.

He is survived by his wife of 61 years, Peggy (Parrish); son, Dave, of Slone Ridge; daughter, Kathy Black (David), of Slone Ridge; 8 grandchildren, 18 great grandchildren, 6 nieces, 3 nephews, and multiple friends. He was preceded in death by brothers J B Sloan, Jack Sloan and sisters Thelma Knight, Jewell Stansell.
