### Obituary of Edwin Dickson

Edwin Dale Dickson, known as Dale by his friends and as Sweetheart, Dad, Daddy, Grandpa and FaFa by his loving family passed away on March 27, 2010 at the age of 96. Mr. Dickson was born in Paris, TN in 1913 at a time before cell phones, computers, and television were invented. His family quickly moved to Ohio where he spent a good part of his life. He married Ruth Stump and they shared 31 years together and raised three children, David, Janie and Lynda. He lost Ruth to cancer in 1972 and later that year he married Lesby Gravenmier, a widow who also had three children, Michael, Deborah and Derrin. He had a very strong faith and spent many years in missionary service and most of his life as a Pastor in the Community of Christ church. He is survived by his wife, three daughters, a son, five grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
