Obituary of Eleanor Kistler

Eleanor Kistler, 96, passed away suddenly on Friday, November 28 at Leesburg Regional Medical Center. Eleanor was born in Battle Creek, Michigan, on June 22, 1918 to Allen LeRoy and Christine (Stansfield) Bauer. She was the twin of Elaine Mildred Bauer Spalding, who passed away in 2012.

She graduated from Battle Creek Central High School and Community Hospital School of Nursing in Battle Creek. 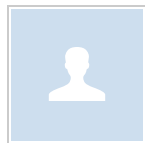
