Obituary of Elsie Mills

The Last Sandefur of Lady Lake Has Passed

Elsie Marie Mills, 74, of Milton, Georgia, died Monday (September 17, 2013) after a lengthy illness. She will be buried in the Lady Lake Cemetery. Born in Leesburg, FL, she moved to Lady Lake from Fruitland Park as a young girl. She went to the elementary school in Lady Lake during its short tenure and graduated from Leesburg High School. For many years she was the primary beautician at the Town & Country Beauty Shop in Lady Lake before opening her own shop in the Sumter County portion of Lady Lake (pre-'The Villages'). Elsie also assisted her father Edker 'Sandy' Sandefur who was the Lady Lake town clerk for 26 years.

The Sandefur family ('Sandy', his wife Francis Marion, and three daughters, Elsie Marie, Lena Juanita "Jane", and Margaret Louise) moved to Lady Lake in 1946. Their home was located in the historic part of town at 124 Rosemary Ave. "Sandy" died in 1997, Francis in 1978, Margaret in 2000, and Jane in 2009. All four are buried in the Lady Lake Cemetery, along with Elsie's

previous two husbands, Henry James Tremblay and Jim Burns Diamond.

Elsie's survivors include her husband James Stewart Mills of Milton, GA., one son, Henry Thomas Tremblay of Prospect, KY, one daughter, Andrea Marie Tremblay of Keystone Heights, FL., two step-sons, Timothy Lee Mills of Milton, GA., and James Stewart Mills Jr. of York, PA, one step-Daughter Mary Francis Crenshaw of Douglasville, GA.; eight grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren.
