Obituary of Emanuel Karageorge

Emanuel A. "Manny" Karageorge, 80, of Leesburg, FL passed away at Leesburg Regional Medical Center on November 7, 2015, following a courageous battle with complications of dementia and pneumonia. Manny was born in Philadelphia, PA on December 5, 1934 and was educated in the early years in Greek and public schools and graduated from West Philadelphia High School in 1953. Manny was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, having served from 1954 to 1957 where he learned aviation electronics then was employed by RCA and GE from 1957 to 1964, during which time he attended college at Ben Franklin Institute and Drexel University. In 1964 he was offered a position with NASA/Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, MD, then he moved his young family to MD and worked for 46 years as an electronics engineer until his retirement in January 2000. Manny was a lover of music and performed, as a teenager, on a local Philadelphia radio station with his A Capella singing group. Once relocated in Maryland, he belonged to a barbershop quartet and local theatre groups, performing in several productions with the NASA/Goddard Players group. Additionally, Manny was a member of the Goddard Boosters softball team for many years. Aside from other hobbies, he enjoyed oil painting and writing. Throughout his life, Manny maintained a focus on health and physical fitness, having run in many road races including two stints in the Marine Corps Marathon. He was an avid golfer, which

ultimately steered him to a life of retirement in Leesburg FL where golf is plentiful and he was able to play to his heart's content. Survivors include his only daughter, brother-in-law, and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his loving wife as well as all four of his siblings.
